SBA Training Classes

What is the SBA Training Program?

The Small Business Assistance (SBA) Training Program offers industry specific training courses to help customers understand and comply with District rules. The District will issue a Certificate of Completion to each participant who successfully completes a class.

What classes are offered?

Current class offerings include:

- **17 CCR – Dry Cleaning Trained Operator Initial Certification and Recertification Courses**

This certification is required by law for dry cleaners who use perchloroethylene. These courses are either to provide initial certification, or to recertify dry cleaning operators who have previously attended the initial certification course and currently hold the original certificate. All attendees must bring their TUFF detectors and photo identification to class. Those seeking recertification must also bring their latest certificate to class.

- **17 CCR 93115 – California Air Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) for Stationary Compression Ignition**

This course covers the requirements of this California laws, which applies to the owners/operators of stationary compression ignition (i.e.diesel) engines.

- **Rule 67.20 – Motor Vehicle and Mobile Equipment Refinishing Operations**

This course covers compliance issues specific to the automotive refinishing industry. Participants will learn how to calculate the volatile organic compound (VOC) content of base coat / clear coat combinations and multi-component coatings. Spray gun, surface preparation, and equipment cleaning requirements will be discussed. Recordkeeping packages will be reviewed and distributed to participants.

- **Rule 67.3 – Metal Parts and Products Coating Operations**

This course covers compliance issues specific to the metal parts coating industry. Participants will learn how to calculate the volatile organic compound (VOC) content of multi-component coatings. Calculations to determine compliance with daily emission limits will be covered. Spray gun, surface preparation, and equipment cleaning requirements will be discussed. Recordkeeping packages will be reviewed and distributed to participants.

- **Rule 67.18 – Marine Coating Operations**

This course covers compliance issues specific to the marine coating industry. Participants will learn how to calculate the volatile organic compound (VOC) content of multi-component coatings. Calculations to determine compliance with daily emission limits will be covered. Spray gun, surface preparation, and equipment cleaning requirements will be discussed. Recordkeeping packages will be reviewed and distributed to participants.
