SBA Training Program

What is the SBA Training Program?

The Small Business Assistance (SBA) Training Program offers industry specific training courses to help customers understand and comply with District rules. The District will issue a Certificate of Completion to each participant who successfully completes a class.

Current class offerings focus on the following industries:

- Dry cleaning
- Motor vehicle and mobile equipment refinishing
- Metal parts and products coating
- Marine coating
- Diesel engines

What do the classes cover?

Each course is tailored to focus on one specific industry and covers compliance issues specific to that industry. Each class explains the applicability, exemptions, and definitions contained in each rule with special emphasis given to rule standards and recordkeeping requirements. Air pollution basics are also discussed with a point-by-point description of District compliance inspections.

Where are classes held?

Classes are held in the APCD Conference Room located at 10124 Old Grove Road in the Scripps Ranch area of San Diego.

What does each class cost?

The fee for each class is \$25 per person and covers the cost of materials. The fee is not refundable. Cancellations must be made three days prior to the course date in order to receive credit for a subsequent class date. You also have the option of having the course material sent to you. The District accepts checks, money orders, Discover Card, and American Express. No cash please.

How do I sign-up for a class?

Registration forms are available from this website. Reservation is not guaranteed until a completed form and payment is received. There are a limited number of spaces available for each class. Registration is on a first come, first served basis, based upon receipt of registration form and payment.
