NOTICE OF PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR EQUIPMENT USED TO CLEAN OR REGENERATE DIESEL PARTICULATE FILTERS AND DIESEL OXIDATION CATALYSTS

Diesel particulate filters (DPFs) or diesel oxidation catalysts (DOCs) that are installed on stationary, portable, or mobile diesel-fueled engines require periodic cleaning and/or regeneration in order to remove built up ash and continue to function properly. The San Diego Air Pollution Control District (District) has determined that equipment used to clean or regenerate DPFs and DOCs has the potential to emit toxic air contaminants and/or particulate matter. Accordingly, pursuant to District Rules 10(a) and (b), the District may require a Permit to install and operate certain types of DPF and DOC cleaning and regeneration equipment.
