NOTICE OF WORKSHOP

**FOR DISCUSSION OF
DRAFT 2016 AIR TOXICS "HOT SPOTS" PROGRAM REPORT**

The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (District) will hold a public meeting to receive comments on its draft 2016 Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Program Report, which is scheduled as follows:

In the way of background, the District prepares an annual report of its "Hot Spots" program in accordance with the State of California's *Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Information and Assessment Act* (AB 2588, Connelly) enacted in 1987. This law requires stationary sources of air pollutants to report the types and quantities of certain substances routinely released by them into the air in San Diego County. This is in concert with the goals of the Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Act, which are to collect toxic air pollutant emissions data, to identify facilities having localized impacts, to ascertain health risks, to notify nearby residents of significant risks, and to reduce any significant risks to acceptable levels.

The District's draft 2016 Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Program Report summarizes the "Hot Spots" program elements, the current status of the program in San Diego County, stationary and mobile source emissions estimates, emissions reduction efforts, and current status of public notifications and risk reduction plans.
