NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION BY THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT OF RENEWAL OF A FEDERAL TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Regulation XIV – Title V Operating Permits, of the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District’s Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to take action on Application No. APCD2010-APP-001258 to renew a federal Title V Operating Permit and action on Application No. APCD2007-APP-985785 to incorporate conditions ensuring compliance with 40 CFR, Part 63, Subpart M – National Emission Standards for Surface Coating of Miscellaneous Metal Parts and Products into that permit. The Title V Operating Permit renewal will be issued to Solar Turbines, Inc. for a turbine manufacturing and testing facility located at 4200 Ruffin Road, San Diego, California (Permit to Operate No. 960991).

The [proposed Title V Operating Permit](#) incorporates conditions necessary to ensure compliance with all applicable federal and District requirements. The facility is currently operating in compliance with all applicable requirements. The proposed permit modification being incorporated into the proposed permit will not result in any change in emissions.

The District is seeking comments on this proposed Title V Operating Permit. Written comments concerning the District’s proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days, commencing on May 12, 2011, and ending on June 10, 2011. Documents relating to the proposed action are available for public review at this address.

Members of the public may petition for a public hearing to provide comments on the proposed Title V Operating Permit. If the Air Pollution Control Officer determines that good cause exists, a public hearing will be scheduled.
