State Budget Proposed for FY 24-25

(as of January 2024)

California faces a serious budget deficit - ~\$38B - \$73B deficit /

- January 2024 Governor Newsom Budget Proposal Budget Acts of 2024 (AB 1812 & SB 917)
- Likely State Budget Impacts
 - On April 4, 2024, Governor Newsom announced an agreement on \$17 billion in early actions to reduce the shortfall - State Budget May Revise Proposal could see other significant budget changes.
 - On April 15, 2024, the California Legislature passed junior Budget Bill AB 106 (Statutes of 24) to provide early action to address \$17 B of the state deficit.
