On behalf of <u>Organization</u>, we urge strong support of the grant application by the Port of San Diego (Port) for the Reduction of Truck Emissions at Port Facilities (RTEP) grant program. This application is in support of the Port's application for right of way funding for the Harbor Drive 2.0 Project.

The Port of San Diego, in conjunction with regional partners at the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) and the California Department of Transportation (CalTrans), have partnered to advance the Harbor Drive 2.0 concept.
