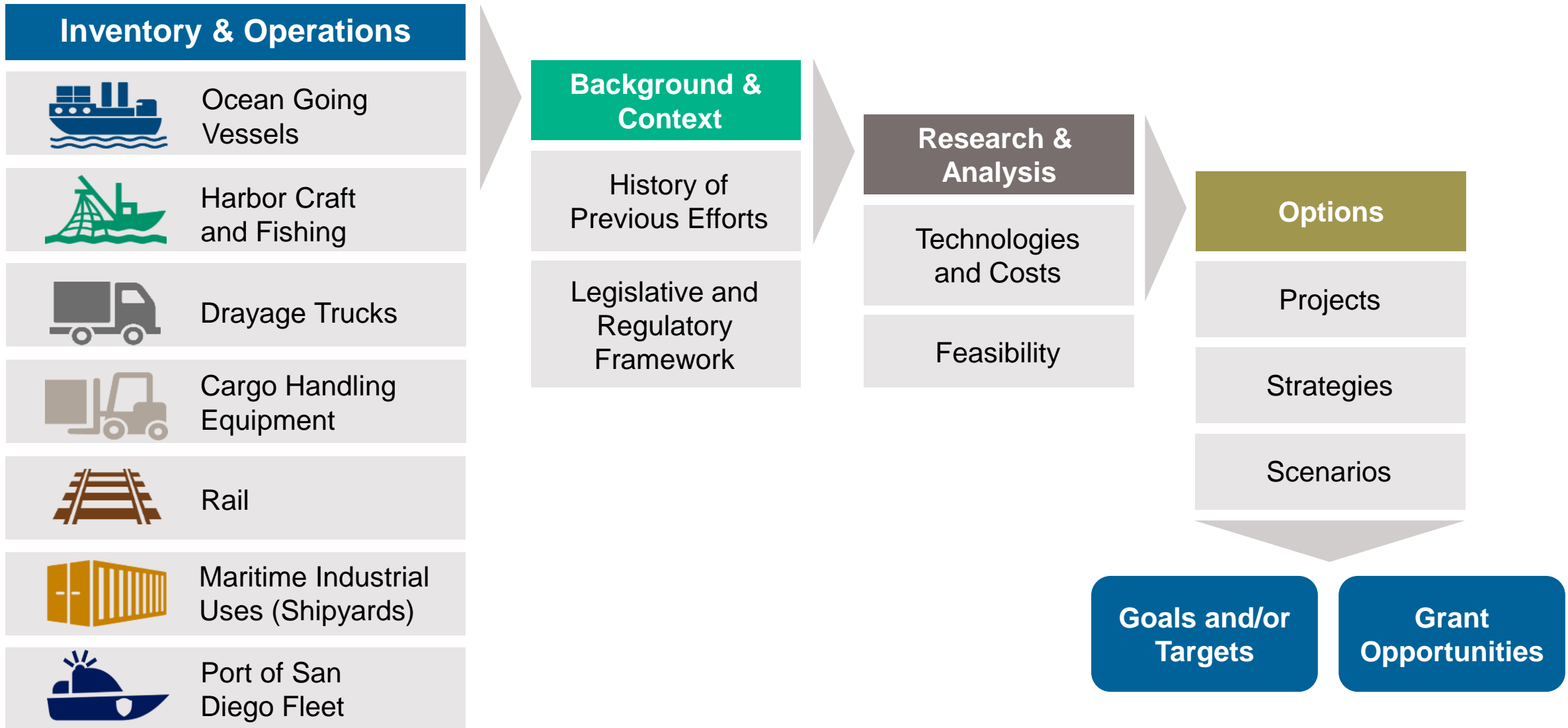


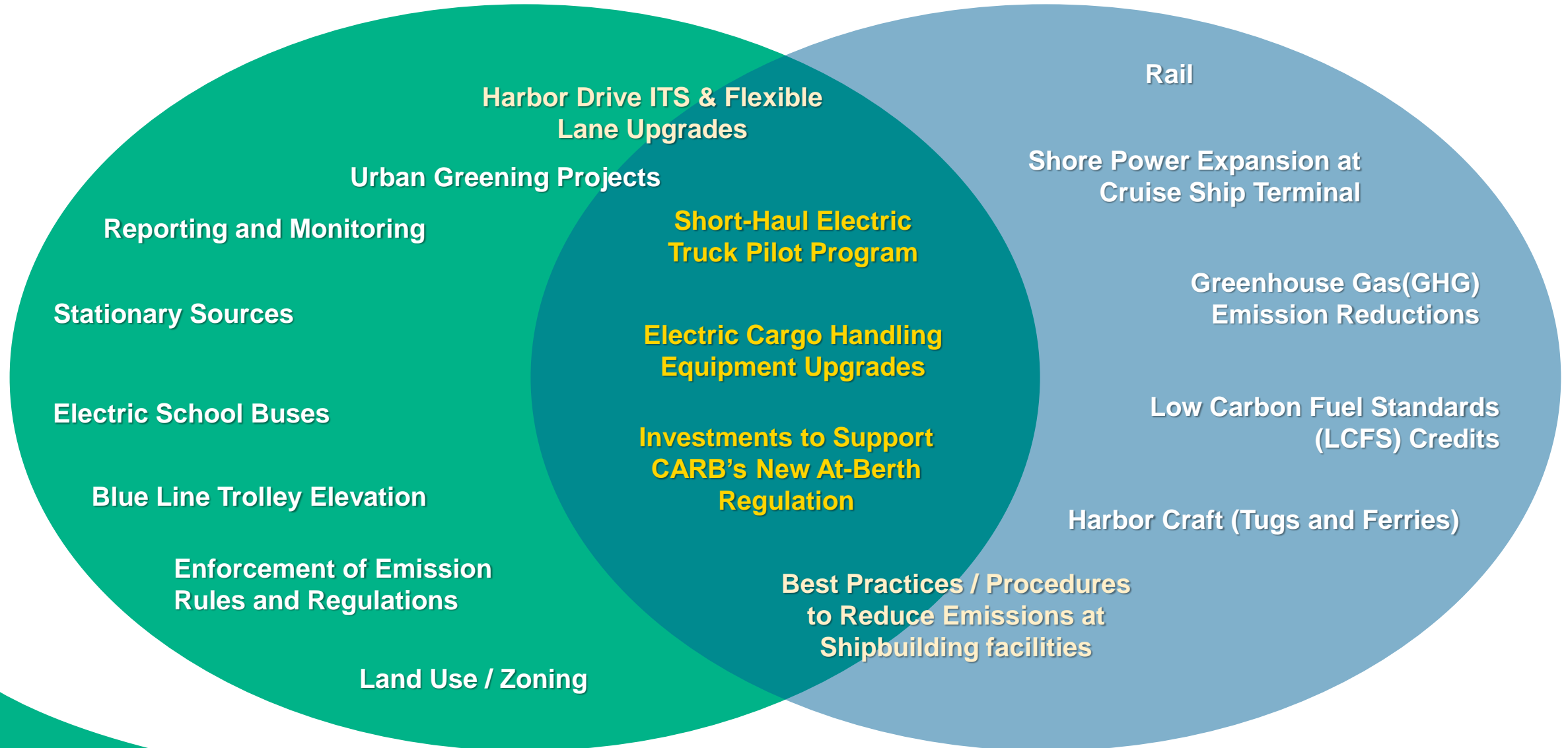

# Maritime Clean Air Strategy

**Port of San Diego MCAS Subcommittee** – The Port of San Diego is in the process of developing a Maritime Clean Air Strategy (MCAS) that will address emission sources that contribute to diesel PM and other pollutants in Portside communities: ships, cargo handling equipment, harbor craft, trucks, and rail. The role of this subcommittee will be to review emissions data and other information from Port staff and Port tenants **to help Port staff identify potential emission reduction goals and priorities to be included in the Port's MCAS.** The Port of San Diego is looking for APCD staff, CARB staff, several community residents, and other interested Steering Committee members to assist them with this effort. At this time, Port staff is targeting to update the Board of Port Commissioners on MCAS items in December 2020, and to complete the MCAS in April 2021.
