5 STEPS CLOSER TO OBTAINING A BUILDING PERMIT

BUILDING DEPARTMENT

You have received this handout because:

A. You are conducting a **renovation** which will disturb 100 square feet or more of building materials.

OR

B. You are conducting a **demolition** which will wreck a load bearing structure.

You must first conduct an asbestos survey prior to receiving your building permit.



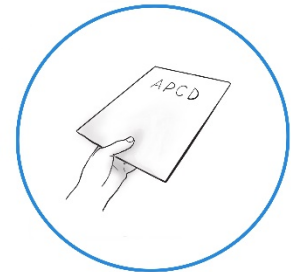

OBTAIN SURVEY

An EPA Building Inspector must survey the building materials that will be disturbed during this project for asbestos.

EPA Building Inspectors may be found in a phone/internet directory. The completed survey must be emailed to the APCD via:

apcdcomp@sdapcd.org.

SUBMIT A NOTIFICATION

If your survey indicates that 100 square feet or more of asbestos will become disturbed and friable during your renovation, you are required to hire a certified asbestos company to first remove the asbestos and submit a **renovation** notification to the APCD.

If you are wrecking a load bearing structure, a **demolition** notification is required to be submitted regardless of the presence of asbestos.

REVIEW OF PAPERWORK

Air Pollution Control District staff will review your survey and forms for accuracy and completeness. You will be notified upon approval, or of any discrepancies.

PRESENT FORM

Present the approved HAZMAT form on or after the date stamped along with any other required paperwork to your Building Department to receive your permit.
