COMPLIANCE ADVISORY **TIME SENSITIVE** Synthetic Minor & Title V Application Submittal

If your facility is planning to apply for a Synthetic Minor permit, please contact our Engineering Department as soon as possible at (858)586-2600 or at APCDengineering@sdapcd.org.

This Advisory is a follow-up to the April 6, 2023, Compliance Advisory¹ regarding Title V permitting requirements in accordance with revised District Rule 1401². That advisory stated that if a facility wishes to limit its potential to emit below Major Source thresholds of 25 tons per year of Oxides of Nitrogen (NO_x) or Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs), the owner/operator of the facility may apply for a Synthetic Minor permit by December, 22, 2023. **However, there have been some changes related to this deadline.**

Additionally, as stated in the April 6, 2023 Advisory, if a facility has emitted or has the potential to emit, either NO_x or VOCs in the amounts equal to or greater than 25 tons per year, that facility is now considered a Major Source of NO_x or VOCs and subject to the Title V permitting requirements. Therefore, the owner/operator of such facility must submit a Title V permit application to the District as soon as possible, but no later than February 21, 2024.
