Notice of Portable Diesel Engine Fleet Emission Requirements

The San Diego Air Pollution Control District (District) hereby advises that the California Air Resources Board (CARB) has requirements for portable diesel engine fleets, governed under the Portable Diesel Engine Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM). Beginning January 1, 2013, portable diesel engines registered in the CARB Portable Equipment Registration Program (PERP) or operating with a District permit or District registration must comply with weighted particulate matter (PM) emission fleet averages expressed as “grams per brake horsepower-hour” (g/bhp-hr).
