### Public Complaints Received by San Diego County Fire Departments

When public complaints are received for odors, smoke and other emission problems, inspections are conducted promptly while the problem is occurring, so we can determine if there is a violation of air pollution regulations. Often times, these incidents may adversely affect public health. **This is why we are asking for your help.** If you receive a public complaint regarding odors, smoke or another emission related problem, we ask that you contact us immediately, so we may act.
