



Incident Response Command Structure

- Support the Unified Command
 - Conduct supplemental air monitoring outside of the hot zone
 - Present Air Quality data information to Unified Command
 - Coordinate public communication through the Unified Command
- APCD are not First Responders
- APCD's Existing Limitations
 - ► Lack Health Effects expertise
 - APCD's Lab instruments could be contaminated from Incident Samples



APCD Response Day 1: Sunday July 12th

- ► 8:50am: explosion and fire occurred on USS Richard Bonhomme
- 5:35pm: APCD notified via County Leadership Office
- > 5:35pm 12:00am: APCD setting up additional sampling locations
- 6:30pm 8:20pm: Issued smoke advisory in English and Spanish

Air Quality Advisory - 7/13/2020

Due to the ship fire burning in San Diego harbor, localized Diego County. As a result fine particulates, or PM2.5 co some smoke impacted areas.

In areas of heavy smoke, assume that air quality levels a for all individuals. In areas with minor smoke impacts, a to unhealthy for sensitive groups.

In areas where you smell smoke it is advised that you lir limit your exposure to fine particulate matter.

Air Samples



Next Steps

- Finalize Incident Response Plan
 - Public workshop planned for late summer/fall 2021
- Provide Governing Board with options on enhanced capabilities
 - ► Fall 2021 meeting
- Continue work with CARB's After-Action Review
 - CARB to host a public workshop in Summer 2021
- Implement a Portside residential air filtration & air monitoring program
