FUNDING QUALIFICATIONS

- Currently operates heavy-duty diesel trucks or buses with a GVWR of greater than 14,000 pounds within the Portside Environmental Justice (EJ) Community. Applicants must operate within purple region on the reverse map for funding eligibility.
- Must operate new ZE heavy-duty vehicle within Portside EJ Community for minimum of 3 years, 52 trips per year, and 104 miles per year.
- Must be in compliance with current air quality regulations.
- Must have access to charging infrastructure for ZE vehicle.

FUNDING AVAILABILITY

- Up to 90% or \$250,000 of eligible ZE heavy-duty vehicle cost (whichever is less) OR
- Up to 90% of 3-year lease payment.
- Additional funding may be available from the Port of San Diego if eligible.
- Funding available on a first-come, first-served basis until funds run out!

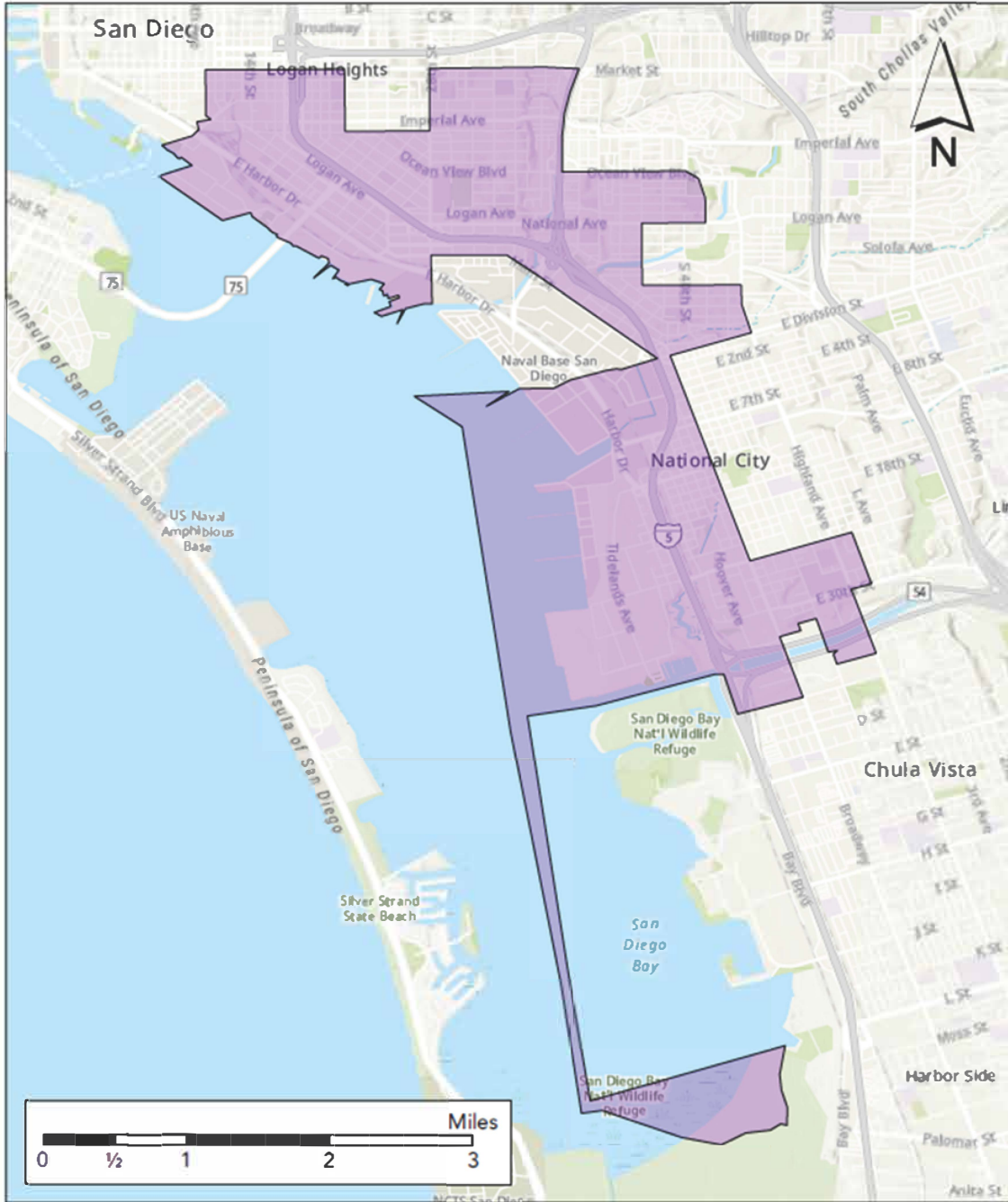
