ACTION:

ON MOTION of Member Smith, seconded by Member Rappolt, the Air Pollution Control District Hearing Board approved the Minutes from May 27, 2021

PETITION BEFORE THE BOARD:

4519 Determination of Rehearing for Navy Regional Southwest: As Permitted Party requests a rehearing in the matter of Permit Appeal Petition on APCD2021-PTO-003677, APCD2021-PTO-003676, and APCD202 I-PTO-003675. The rehearing is for appeal of permit conditions drawn from District Rule 69.4.1 and 63 CFR subpart ZZZZ. The matter was heard on April 8, 2021.

ACTION 1.1:

A Motion was made by Member Rodriguez, seconded by Member Tonner, to approve the Rehearing for Navy Regional Southwest based on good cause being established that the Petitioner was not given due process to present their case before the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District Hearing Board.

The Motion failed due to lack of majority vote.

ON MOTION of Member Powers, seconded by Member Rappolt, the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District Hearing Board denied the request for rehearing for Navy Regional Southwest due to lack of good cause.

REASONS FOR DECISION:

After reviewing the Petitioner's petition and considering Petitioner's argument, the Hearing Board did not find good cause for exercising its discretion to rehear the petition. Petitioner's subject matter expert was allowed sufficient time to testify during the permit appeal hearing on April 8, 2021. Additional time for testimony was properly denied pursuant to Hearing Board Rule 20, which requires irrelevant and unduly repetitious evidence to be excluded.
