

AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT HEARING BOARD EMERGENCY VARIANCE HEARING July 25, 2022 2:30 P.M.

HEARING OFFICER: Ruth Vilmarie Rodriguez, Chair, County of San Diego Air Pollution Control District Hearing Board

4526 Sumitomo Electric Interconnect Products – Manufacturer of Heat Shrinkable Tubing - Petitioner requests an Emergency Variance 4526 filed on July 25, 2022, from Condition 4 of permit APCD2020-PTO-003630, due to a bad batch of ozone decomposing chemical (Carulite 200) resulting in higher emissions of ozone than permitted for equipment associated with an air pollution control device located at 915 Armolite Dr., San Marcos, CA.

ACTION: Pursuant to Air Pollution Control District Hearing Board Rule 14 and Health and Safety Code section 42359.5, Chair Rodriguez received evidence, closed the Hearing, and denied the Emergency Variance under District Permit APCD2022-PTO-003630:

Petitioner and those present reviewed Hearing Board Rule 14 and APCD Rules 97 and 98 describing the requirements for petitioning an Emergency Variance. Petitioner is not seeking an Emergency Variance to avoid seeking an Interim Variance or hearing notice requirements. Based on testimony provided, the Petition did not meet the Emergency Variance requirements.

Based upon testimony given and evidence provided, Chair Rodríguez determined that good cause was not found, determined that emergency action is not warranted and closed the hearing with denial of Petition 4526 for Emergency Variance.
