






Emission Contributions Residential Cancer Risk 48.2 in One Million

Pacific Ship's Risk Reduction Plan

May 2022

• Plan was submitted to the District

September 2022

- Revised Plan was submitted to the District, which proposes to:
 - > Capture and control certain welding emissions to reduce toxic emissions

Current Status

• District proposed permit conditions that align with Pacific Ship's proposal



• Proposed permit conditions are still being discussed between Pacific Ship and the District

Next Steps

District to take final action on Risk Reduction Plan and make it enforceable

Pacific Ship to implement the RRP

Annual notifications will continue until the plan is fully implemented and the risks are below the thresholds

Pacific Ship will be re-evaluated based on their 2023 emissions.


