NOTICE OF HEALTH RISK REDUCTION PLAN MODIFICATION SUBMITTED BY SUPERIOR READYMIX LP

The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (District) has received a proposal to modify a previously approved health risk reduction plan under a new Application APCD2022-RRP-990029 from Superior Readymix LP, for their asphalt batch plant located at 500 N. Tulip Street, Escondido, California 92025.

A Risk Reduction Plan for Superior Ready mix to comply with District Rule 1210 – *Toxic Air Contaminant Health Risks Public Notification and Risk Reduction* was previously approved by the District in June 2022. The new application filed by Superior Ready Mix to modify the risk reduction plan now proposes a source test to determine a site-specific emission factor for Nickel emissions. The emission calculations used for the approved risk reduction plan used default emission factors. The emission factor established from the source test can be used to re-evaluate the existing asphalt production. The source test protocol will be subject to approval from the District and if this proposal is approved by the District this facility will be subject to periodic testing to ensure ongoing compliance with District Rule 1210.
