**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
TO APPROVE AN EMISSION REDUCTION CREDIT BY
THE SAN DIEGO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL
DISTRICT**

The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District hereby gives notice that in accordance with Rule 26.0 of the District's Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control District has made a preliminary decision to approve banking of an Emission Reduction Credit for the shutdown of two 12.6 MMBtu/hr cogeneration turbines/generators (District Permit Nos. 2009-PTO-008255 and 008256), previously operated at Grossmont District Hospital located at 5555 Grossmont Center Dr, La Mesa, CA 91942.

An evaluation of the air pollution impacts of this proposal was performed by the District and it was determined that all applicable District Rules and Regulations will be met. The equipment is no longer operational and the permits are no longer active. The total emissions reductions from the shutdown of the turbines are as follows: 9.09 tons per year of oxides of nitrogen.

The District is seeking comments on this proposed permit action. Written comments concerning the District's proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days, commencing on November 1, 2019, and ending on December 1, 2019.
