NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION TO APPROVE A SOURCE OF AIR POLLUTION BY THE SAN DIEGO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District hereby gives notice that in accordance with Rule 20.2 of the District's Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to approve an Authority to Construct for four emergency engines/generators to be operated at Gilead Sciences, Inc. The engines are 757 horsepower each and will be used for unforeseen power outages. They will be located at 4010 Ocean Ranch Blvd, Oceanside, CA 92056.

An evaluation of the air pollution impacts of this proposal was performed by the District and it was determined that all applicable District Rules and Regulations will be met when the engines comply with conditions prescribed by the District.

Permit conditions will limit operations to no more than 34 hours per year for testing and maintenance. The combined potential to emit for all four engines are approximately 862 pounds per year of oxides of nitrogen, 113 pounds per year of carbon monoxide, 45 pounds per year of volatile organic compounds, 32 pounds per year of particulate matter less than or equal to 10 microns in diameter.

The District is seeking comments on this proposed permit action. Written comments concerning the District's proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days, commencing on February 7, 2020, and ending on March 8, 2020.
