NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION BY THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT TO ISSUE A RENEWAL FEDERAL TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Regulation XIV - Title V Operating Permits of the San Diego Air Pollution Control District's (District's) Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to approve application APCD2020-APP-006451 to renew federal Title V Operating Permit APCD2008-TVP-979681 for SDG&E Cuyamaca Peak Energy, a power generation facility located at 200 N Johnson Ave, El Cajon, CA 92020. In addition to the renewal, a preliminary decision has been made to approve two minor modification applications: APCD2017-APP-005201 to incorporate engine testing and tuning conditions for the turbine, as well as APCD2017-APP-005184 for the addition of a new natural gas fired engine APCD2020-PTO-003552 to the Title V permit.

The District performed an evaluation of the air pollution impacts of this proposal. The equipment is expected to operate in compliance with all applicable District Rules and Regulations and all applicable state and federal requirements. The proposed Title V Operating Permit incorporates conditions necessary to ensure compliance with all federal, state and District requirements. The facility is currently operating in compliance with all applicable federal, state and District requirements.

The District is seeking comments on the applications for renewal and minor modifications to the Title V Operating Permit for this facility. Written comments concerning the District's proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days commencing on September 15, 2021 and ending on October 15, 2021.
