**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION BY THE
SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT
TO ISSUE A NEW FEDERAL TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT**

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Regulation XIV - Title V Operating Permits of the San Diego Air Pollution Control District's Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to approve application APCD2016-APP- 004597 for an initial Federal Title V Operating Permit APCD2017-TVP-00043 for Goal Line L.P. located at 555 N Tulip Street, Escondido, CA 92025.

The District performed an evaluation of the air pollution impacts of this proposal. The equipment is expected to operate in compliance with all applicable District Rules and Regulations and all applicable federal requirements. The proposed Title V Operating Permit incorporates conditions necessary to ensure compliance with all federal and District requirements including Title IV Acid Rain program requirements. The facility is currently operating in compliance with District requirements.

The District is seeking comments on the Title V Operating Permit for this facility. Written comments concerning the District's proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days commencing on August 25, 2017 and ending on September 24, 2017. Documents relating to the proposed action are available for public review at this address.

Members of the public may petition for a public hearing to receive comments on the proposed Title V Operating Permit. If the Air Pollution Control Officer determines that good cause exists, a public hearing will be scheduled.

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
