**NOTICE OF INTENT
TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR PROPOSED
SILVER LINING CREMATIONS BY THE SAN DIEGO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL
DISTRICT**

Notice, pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21092 and California Code of Regulations Title 14 Section 15072, is hereby given that the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (APCD) is proposing to adopt a Negative Declaration addressing Silver Lining Cremations, based on Initial Study findings prepared pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.

The APCD has received an application for an Authority to Construct and Permit to Operate to commence operation of a new crematory, Silver Lining Cremations, located at 421 South Andreason Drive, Escondido, California. APCD, acting as lead agency, has completed an Initial Study for the proposed project. The Initial Study found no substantial evidence that the proposed project would have a significant adverse effect on the environment.

On the basis of these findings, a proposed Negative Declaration has been prepared. APCD is seeking comments on the proposed Negative Declaration. The 30-day review period commences on January 26, 2022 and ends on February 25, 2022. All comments must be submitted in writing or via e-mail and received at the APCD office by 5:00 p.m. on February 25, 2022.
