NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION TO APPROVE A SOURCE OF AIR POLLUTION BY THE SAN DIEGO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District hereby gives notice that in accordance with Rule 20.3 of the District's Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to approve an Authority to Construct for an aggregate conveying system as part of an aggregate washing plant, to be operated by Hanson Aggregates PSW at 8514 Mast Blvd, San Diego, CA 92071.

An evaluation of the air pollution impacts of this proposal was performed by the District and it was determined that all applicable District Rules and Regulations will be met when the equipment complies with conditions prescribed by the District.

The equipment will operate for 12 hours per day and up to 4,380 hours per year. The potential to emit for this equipment is approximately 65 pounds per day and 12 tons per year of particulate matter less than or equal to 10 microns in diameter.

The District is seeking comments on this proposed permit action. Written comments concerning the District's proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days, commencing on January 17, 2020, and ending on February 16, 2020.
