**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
TO APPROVE AN EMISSION REDUCTION CREDIT BY
THE SAN DIEGO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL
DISTRICT**

The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District hereby gives notice that in accordance with Rule 26.0 of the District’s Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control District has made a preliminary decision to approve banking of an Emission Reduction Credit for the shutdown of a polyester web film dyeing operation (District Permit No. APCD2017-PTO-002872), previously operated at the Saint-Gobain Solar Gard facility located at 1865 Ord Way, Oceanside, CA 92056.

An evaluation of the air pollution impacts of this proposal was performed by the District, and it was determined that the proposal will meet all applicable District Rules and Regulations. The equipment is no longer operational, and the permit is no longer active. The total emissions reductions from the shutdown of the polyester web film dyeing operation are as follows: 8.20 tons per year of volatile organic compounds.

The District is seeking comments on this proposed permit action. Written comments concerning the District’s proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days, commencing on August 18, 2020, and ending on September 18, 2020.
