NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION TO APPROVE A SOURCE OF AIR POLLUTION BY THE SAN DIEGO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District hereby gives notice that in accordance with Rule 20.2 of the District's Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer has made a preliminary decision to approve an Authority to Construct for each of six emergency engines/generators (District Application Nos. 2019-APP-005800 through 005805), to be operated at the University of California San Diego. The six engines to be used for unforeseen power outages are rated between 315 and 1,214 horsepower and located at 9280 Regents Road, La Jolla, CA 92037 and 9500 Gilman Dr #0089, La Jolla, CA 92093.

An evaluation of the air pollution impacts of this proposal was performed by the District and it was determined that all applicable District Rules and Regulations will be met when the engines comply with conditions prescribed by the District.

Permit conditions will limit operations to no more than 47 hours per year for testing and maintenance. The combined potential to emit for all six engines are approximately 1,161 pounds per year of oxides of nitrogen, 113 pounds per year of carbon monoxide, 17 pounds per year of volatile organic compounds, 12 pounds per year of particulate matter less than or equal to 10 microns in diameter, and 1.3 pounds per year of oxides of sulfur.

The District is seeking comments on this proposed permit action. Written comments concerning the District's proposed action may be submitted for a period of 30 days, commencing on May 18, 2019, and ending on June 18, 2019.
