FINDINGS OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD
IN RESPECT TO THE ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION X REPEALING
EXISTING NEW SOURCE PERFORMANCE STANDARDS (NSPS) SUBPART Db AND
ADDING BY REFERENCE FEDERAL NSPS SUBPART Db – STANDARDS OF
PERFORMANCE FOR INDUSTRIAL-COMMERCIAL-INSTITUTIONAL STEAM
GENERATING UNITS

- A. Pursuant to section 40727 of the Health and Safety Code, the Air Pollution Control Board of the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District makes the following findings:
 - (1) (Necessity) The repeal of existing New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) Subpart Db and addition by reference of Federal NSPS Subpart Db are necessary to incorporate amendments to the Federal NSPS in order to implement and enforce the most recent version of Federal NSPS Subpart Db.
 - (2) (Authority) The repeal of existing Subpart Db and addition by reference of Federal NSPS Subpart Db are authorized by Health and Safety Code section 40702.
 - (3) (Clarity) The Federal NSPS Subpart Db can be easily understood by persons directly affected by it.
 - (4) (Consistency) An analysis is not required by Health and Safety Code section 40727.2. The Board finds that the proposed adoption of Federal NSPS Subpart Db merely incorporates by reference a Federal NSPS adopted pursuant to Section 111 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. § 7411), and that Federal NSPS Subpart Db is in harmony with, and not in conflict with or contrary to, existing statutes, court decisions, and state and federal regulations.
 - (5) (Non-duplication) The addition by reference of Federal NSPS Subpart Db will not duplicate existing district or federal requirements, but merely incorporates the Federal NSPS Subpart Db.
 - (6) (Reference) The addition by reference of Federal NSPS Subpart Db is necessary to implement and enforce Federal NSPS Subpart Db in accordance with Clean Air Act section 111 (42 U.S.C. § 7411).
- B. The Air Pollution Control Board further finds pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 40001 that the addition by reference of Federal NSPS Subpart Db and its amendments is required to implement amendments to the Federal NSPS and will not interfere with the attainment of ambient air quality standards.
- C. The Air Pollution Control Board further finds that an assessment of socioeconomic impacts is not required by Health and Safety Code section 40728.5 for addition by reference of Federal NSPS Subpart Db because it will not significantly affect air quality or emission limitations.
- D. The Air Pollution Control Board further finds that it is certain that there is no possibility that the repeal of existing Regulation X, Subpart Db and addition by reference of Federal NSPS Subpart Db may have a significant adverse effect on the environment, and the repeal of existing Regulation X, Subpart Db and addition by reference of Federal NSPS Subpart Db are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15061(b)(3).

(DISTRICT: ALL)

OVERVIEW:

New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) are promulgated as Subparts by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and apply throughout the country. Subpart Db – Standards of Performance for Industrial-Commercial-Institutional Steam Generating Units, was first promulgated by EPA in November 1986. A modified version of federal Subpart Db was adopted by the Air Pollution Control Board in December 1987 and updated in September 1993, as part of District Regulation X (Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources).

EPA amended the standard several times since 1993, causing the Regulation X version to become outdated. Therefore, the District is proposing to repeal Regulation X version and adopt Subpart Db and its current amendments by reference, and a copy of federal Subpart Db and all amendments will be included in Appendix C of the District Rules and Regulations. This will satisfy federal requirements and simplify the process for adopting any future EPA amendments. Following this action, the District will request EPA delegation to implement and enforce Subpart Db.

Subpart Db regulates steam generating units for which construction, modification, or reconstruction commenced after June 19, 1984, and that have a heat input capacity greater than 29 MW (100 million Btu/hour). Sulfur dioxide, particulate matter, and nitrogen oxide concentration standards are specified and test methods, emission monitoring, reporting and recordkeeping requirements are provided. All steam generating units subject to Subpart Db currently comply with all applicable requirements.

There was no opposition to adopting Subpart Db by reference at the public workshop held on March 21, 2001.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The recommended action will have no fiscal impact on the District.

RECOMMENDATION: AIR POLLUTION CONTROL OFFICER

Adopt the resolution amending Regulation X of the District Rules and Regulations by repealing existing Subpart Db as adopted by the Board on December 15, 1987, and adding federal Subpart Db and its subsequent amendments by referencing the Federal Register and make appropriate findings:

- (i) of necessity, authority, clarity, consistency, non-duplication and reference as required by Section 40727 of the State Health and Safety Code;
- (ii) that an analysis of existing requirements applicable to the source or category is not required by Section 40727.2 of the Health and Safety Code because the proposed amendments do not impose new or more stringent requirements;
- (iii) that repealing existing Subpart Db, and adding federal Subpart Db and its subsequent amendments will alleviate a problem and will promote attainment of ambient air quality standards (Section 40001 of the State Health and Safety Code);
- (iv) that an assessment of the socioeconomic impact is not required by Section 40728.5of the State Health and Safety Code because repealing existing Subpart Db, and adding federal Subpart Db and its subsequent amendments will not significantly affect air quality or emission limitations; and
- (v) that it is certain there is no possibility that repealing existing Subpart Db, and adding federal Subpart Db and its subsequent amendments may have a significant adverse effect on the environment, and this action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15061(b)(3).

RESOLUTION REPEALING EXISTING NEW SOURCE PERFORMANCE STANDARDS (NSPS) SUBPART Db OF REGULATION X AND ADDING BY REFERENCE FEDERAL NSPS SUBPART Db TO REGULATION X OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

following resolution is adopted:			

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Air Pollution Control Board, pursuant to Section 40702 of the Health and Safety Code, adopted Rules and Regulations of the Air Pollution Control District of San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, said Board now desires to amend said Rules and Regulations; and

WHEREAS, notice has been given and a public hearing has been had relating to the amendment of said Rules and Regulations pursuant to Section 40725 of the Health and Safety Code.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the San Diego County Air Pollution Control Board that the Rules and Regulations of the Air Pollution Control District of San Diego County be and hereby are amended as follows:

1. Subpart Db is deleted in its entirety.

SUBPART Db - Standards of Performance for Industrial-Commercial-Institutional Steam Generating Units is deleted in its entirety.

2. Amendment to Regulation X adding Federal NSPS Subpart Db by reference is to read as follows:

REGULATION X. STANDARDS OF PERFORMANCE FOR NEW STATIONARY SOURCES (NSPS)

The provisions of Part 60, Chapter I, Title 40, of the Code of Federal Regulations, (40 CFR 60), applicable to the subparts listed in this Regulation are hereby adopted by reference on the date shown and made part of the District Rules and Regulations. Whenever any source is subject to more than one rule, regulation, provision, or requirement relating to the control of any air contaminant, in cases of conflict or duplication the most stringent rule, regulation, provision, or requirement shall apply.

Resolution - Subpart Db, Reg. X 3/26/01

All new sources of air pollution and all modified or reconstructed sources of air pollution shall comply with the applicable standards, criteria, and requirements set forth herein. For the purpose of this Regulation, the word "Administrator" as used in 40 CFR 60 shall mean the Air Pollution Control Officer of the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District, except that the Air Pollution Control Officer shall not be empowered to approve alternate test methods, alternate standards or work practices. Other deviations, if any, from the provisions of 40 CFR 60 which are adopted by the Air Pollution Control Board are noted in the reference to the affected Subpart.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) retains concurrent enforcement authority for these standards pursuant to Section 113 of the federal Clean Air Act, as amended, if the EPA Administrator desires to exercise it.

The addition of federal Subparts by reference to Regulation X shall take effect and be in force on the date of delegation of enforcement authority to the Air Pollution Control District by the U.S. EPA.
