The California Air Resources Board (ARB) and the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (District) will hold a training workshop to discuss requirements and local implementation of the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) Subpart ZZZZ at Area Sources, applicable to stationary reciprocating internal combustion engines (RICE).

The applicable requirements of this NESHAP depend on whether the RICE is located at an Area Source or a Major Source. A Major Source is any facility that emits or has the potential to emit at least 10 tons per year of an individual hazardous air pollutant (HAP) or 25 tons per year of combined HAPs. An Area Source is any facility that is not a Major Source. Most facilities are Area Sources. An additional training workshop for Major Sources is scheduled for January 30, 2013 from 1:30pm-5:00pm.
