NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO DISCUSS PROPOSED NEW EMISSION INVENTORY FEE AND FEE INCREASES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-27

Federal and state law allows the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (District) to adopt fees to recover the costs for services provided to administer mandated air pollution control programs. The District's fees, both those charged on an hourly basis and fixed (flat) fees, are specified in Rule 40 (Permit and Other Fees), which includes fees for services related to air quality permit applications, permit renewals, emission measurements ("source tests"), asbestos notifications, and emission inventory services. District rules, including Rule 40, can be accessed on the District's Rules website at <https://bit.ly/SDAPCDRules>.

On May 21, 2021, the San Diego County Air Pollution Control District Governing Board (Governing Board) adopted a cost recovery plan (<https://bit.ly/40nM4Ut>). The District is proposing fee amendments to implement the cost recovery plan for Fiscal Year 2026-27. Proposed FY 2026-27 amendments to Rule 40 include fee increases of up to 15% for services related to air quality permit applications, permit renewals, source tests, and asbestos notifications. These proposed FY 2026-27 amendments to Rule 40, if adopted, would take effect on July 1, 2026. The District is also proposing revisions to Rule 40 for a new flat fee for sources not subject to Time and Material (T&M) emissions inventory fees, to recover costs for mandated emission inventory services. As mentioned at the October 27, 2025, workshop, the proposed emission inventory fee amendments to Rule 40, if adopted, would take effect on February 12, 2026.

NOTICE, pursuant to the State of California Health and Safety Code Section 42311, is hereby given of a public hearing on **Thursday, December 11, 2025, at 2:00 p.m.** before the District Governing Board, for the purpose of receiving public comments on proposed amendments, including new and increased fees, to District Rule 40 (Permit and Other Fees). Those wishing to participate in the public hearing and/or provide comments on the proposed amendments to Rule 40 should visit the Governing Board's website at <https://bit.ly/3F8NXsQ>. A Governing Board hearing to consider the adoption of proposed amendments to Rule 40 will be held no sooner than 30 days after the December 11, 2025, public hearing.

The Governing Board may consider modifications to the proposed amendments, which may be deemed appropriate. Written comments are welcome and must be received by December 10, 2025. Comments should be emailed to APCDRules@sdapcd.org.
