Air Improvement Relief Effort

The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District is distributing free air purifiers and up to two filters to households affected by sewage odors near the Tijuana River Valley. The purifiers provided through the Air Improvement Relief Effort are intended to help improve indoor air quality and filter hydrogen sulfide, a colorless gas with a strong odor similar to “rotten eggs,” that is produced by the cross-border wastewater and sewage flows.

Eligible households in the City of San Diego communities of Otay Mesa West, San Ysidro, Egger Highlands, Nestor, and Tijuana River Valley, and the City of Imperial Beach, can register online – use this QR code or link to reach the application.
