

2024-2025 Air Improvement Relief Effort (AIRE) Indoor Air Purifier Distribution Program

Terms & Conditions

Eligibility

- The San Diego Air Pollution Control District ("the District") will provide a limited number of free portable air purifier to households affected by ambient odors from the Tijuana River Valley.
- Distribution is limited to one air purifier and one replacement filter per eligible household within the eligible service area. Additional replacement filters are the responsibility of the participant.
- Applicants must be over the age of 18 and submit application through the District's online portal or through an SDAPCD authorized partner event.
- Program applicants must be prepared to confirm their identity & home address with any of the following documentation:

Option 1: Government issued ID with address on your application

Option 2: Government issued ID with different address must also provide, a copy of the MOST CURRENT utility bill (electricity, water, internet, etc.) that shows applicants name and address.

<u>Option 3:</u> Student ID card for student attending an eligible middle school or high school AND a copy of the MOST CURRENT utility bill (electricity, water, internet, etc.) that shows applicants name and address.

Participant Responsibilities & Acknowledgements

- The recipient certifies that the information provided in this application, including any
 address verification/school enrollment documentation presented at registration and/or
 distribution events, is accurate to the best of their knowledge and that any false
 statements, information, or answers will be grounds for disqualification from participation
 in the program and eligibility to receive an air purifier.
- As the recipient of the air purifier, I agree to provide feedback on the portable air filtration unit and replacement filters, such as performance and end-user experiences, at the request of the District.
- Products not picked up during the specified dates/times will be distributed to the next eligible recipients.
- The recipient agrees not to resell the air purifier or replacement filter received within two years of receipt.
- If home delivery is selected as the option of distribution, the District is not responsible for lost or stolen equipment.
