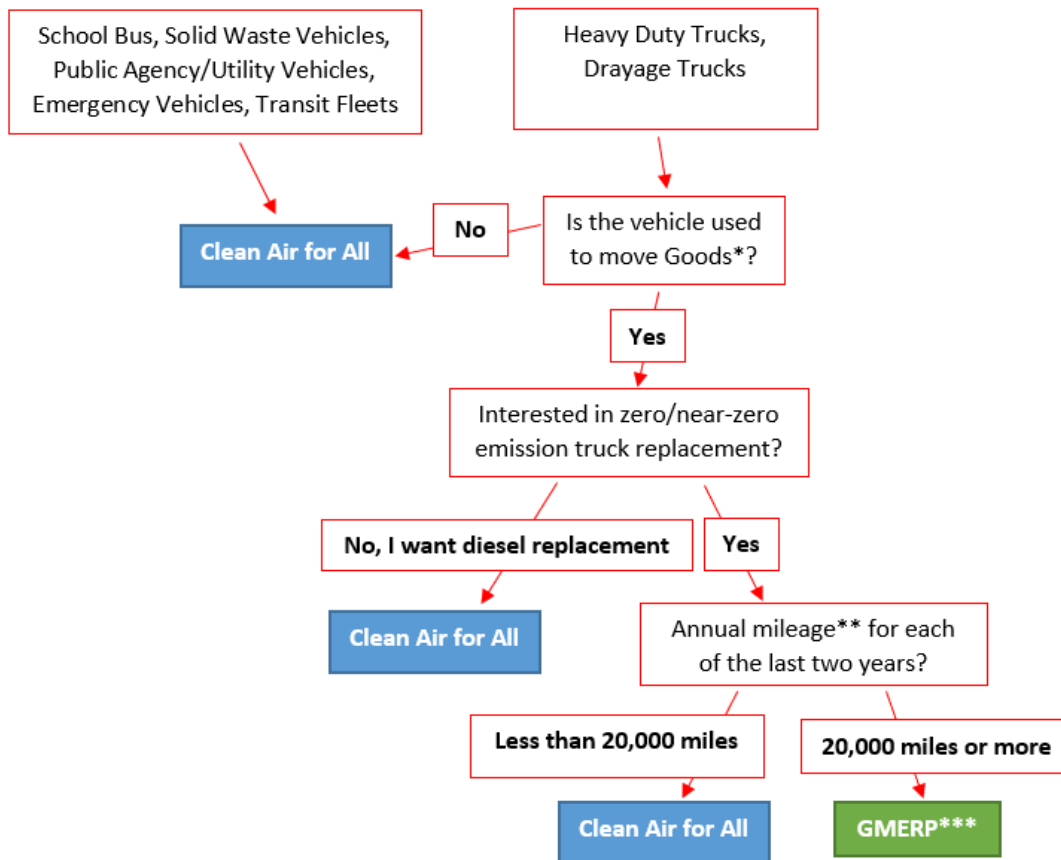


APCD On-Road Guidance Document

The San Diego Air Pollution Control District (APCD) is accepting on-road vehicle applications for the Clean Air for All Grant Program and the Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program (GMERP). The Clean Air for All Grant Program consists of the Carl Moyer Program, FARMER, and the Community Air Protection Program (CAPP). The Voucher Incentive Program (VIP) will be available in the Spring of 2021 and is currently **not** accepting applications at this time. In order to identify which on-road grant program your company should apply for, please follow the flowchart below.



*Goods is defined as something movable and is part of a transaction that involves a contract for the sale of the goods.

**10,000 miles or more for Class 5 and Class 6 vehicles. 20,000 miles or more for Class 7 and Class 8 vehicles.

***GMERP only accepts vehicle classes 5-8. Clean Air for All accepts vehicle classes 4-8.
